Frederick M. Azar, M.D. '94, has been elected as Chief of Staff of the Campbell Clinic, succeeding James H. Beaty, M.D.



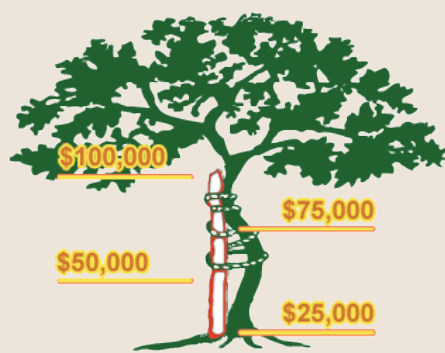
