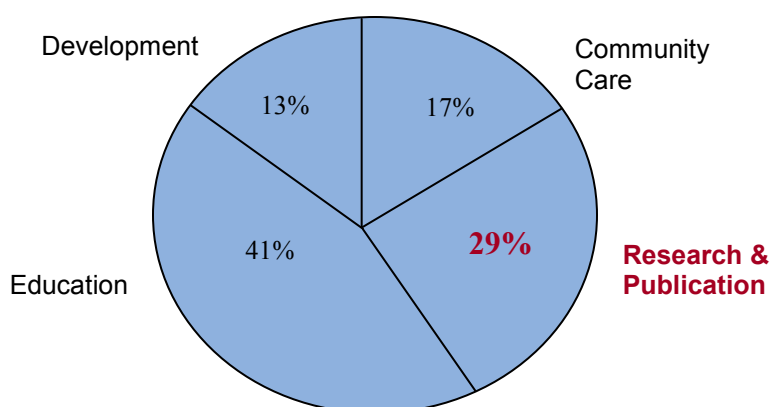

In 2011, our expenditures were distributed as follows:



### Research and Publication (29%)

- Graphics and production costs associated with preparation of *Campbell's Operative Orthopaedics*
- Graphics and production costs associated with preparation of academic manuscripts, scientific posters and exhibits and presentations
- Library Costs: Journal Subscriptions, Book Collections (updating for new editions and additional new holdings)
- Salaries and Benefits for Administrative Staff with responsibilities for assisting in research and publication. (In July, a Research Nurse was hired to assist with research studies.)
- Miscellaneous Supplies in the Library and Editorial offices of The Campbell Foundation
