Here's a peek into how your support will be used:

Educational Travel Support – your contributions will provide support for educational travel for our residents to attend training courses away from our local campus and clinic. In the 2011 – 2012 academic year for example, our residents attended 115 days of educational conferences EXTERNAL to the training accomplished on site. Corporate support for this sort of travel has decreased significantly in recent years, so **your contributions are vital!**



Educational Supplies – your gifts will assist residents in acquiring the supplies needed for their training including surgical loupes, lead protective equipment, books and other supplies.

Research Support – your donations make possible research projects conducted by residents and led by staff. Current projects are exploring the impacts of patient behavioral factors and lifestyle choices (such as obesity, smoking or preoperative narcotic use) on orthopaedic outcomes. A Research Nurse Coordinator has been hired to assist with the administrative and regulatory pathways for this research.
