

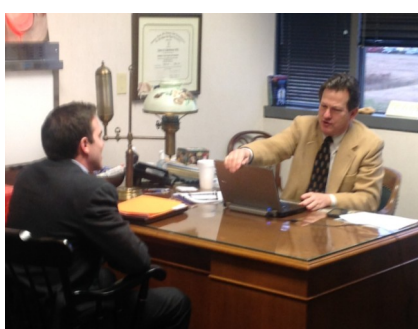

On November 14th, along with all orthopaedic residents across the U.S., Campbell residents completed the Orthopaedics In-Training Exam (OITE). This year's exam consisted of 275 questions, divided among 12 sections. The exam is now administered in a completely online format, and provides a measure of orthopaedic knowledge compared with same-level peers nationwide.



On October 25, the Campbell Foundation was honored as one of several select sites to host the 2015 North American Traveling Fellows of the AOA. This group of five outstanding orthopaedic surgeons was selected following a highly competitive application process, and toured for five weeks to prominent orthopaedic centers in the US and Canada, in a significant clinical and scientific exchange program.
