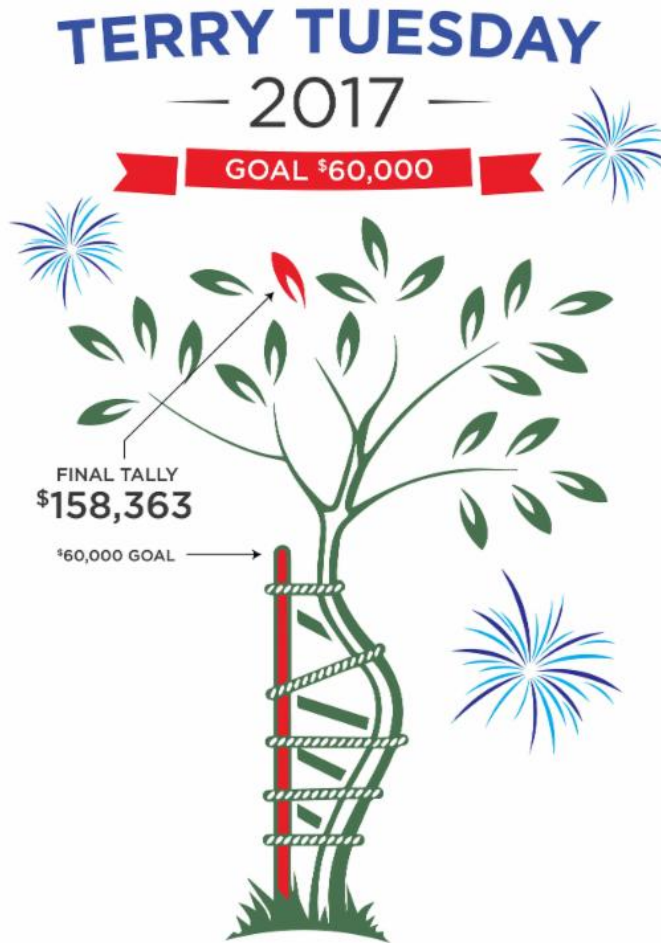

Visiting Professor Lecture Series

For the past two years, the Campbell pediatric team has hosted the current President of the Pediatric Orthopaedic Society of North America (POSNA) in Memphis as part of the Campbell Foundation Visiting Professor Program.

On January 11th, Dr. Rick Schwend, Director of Clinical Research and Professor of Orthopaedics and Pediatrics at the University of Missouri, Kansas City and University of Kansas, as well as the Division of Orthopaedics at Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City, Missouri was our distinguished professor with the keynote address *Differential Rod Contouring and Other Techniques for 3-D Correction of Adolescent Idiopathic Scoliosis*.

This effort, which is now a part of our annual training curriculum for pediatric orthopaedics, is comprised of a half day program which includes interactive case discussions with staff, residents, and other allied health personnel working with pediatric orthopaedic patients, held at Le Bonheur Children's Hospital.

Research in Action

The Campbell Shoulder, Sports, & Elbow Research Group are now the lead investigators of a multi-center, prospective, randomized-control trial measuring post-operative patient narcotic consumption.

The purpose of this study is to compare pain relief, opioid use, and complication rates between two alternative anesthesia protocols for arthroscopic rotator cuff repair. Using patient diaries, the study seeks to verify the efficacy of a multi-modal pain management protocol that safely decreases post-operative opioid use. Patient enrollment into the study will continue through 2018.
