To earn the certification, each applicant must pass a rigorous, 3-hour exam, administered by the Society of Clinical Research Associates (SOCRA). The certification reflects a common, strong foundation of knowledge and practice in research regulations and Good Clinical Practice (GCP).

Only approximately one-third (33%) of research associates carry this certification.

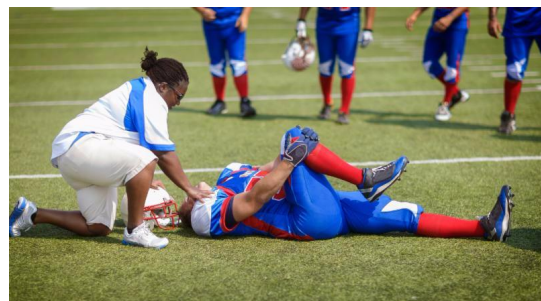
