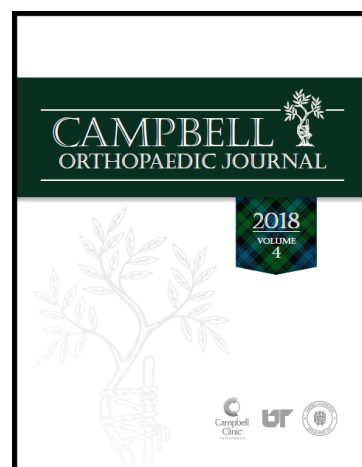

Visiting Professor Series



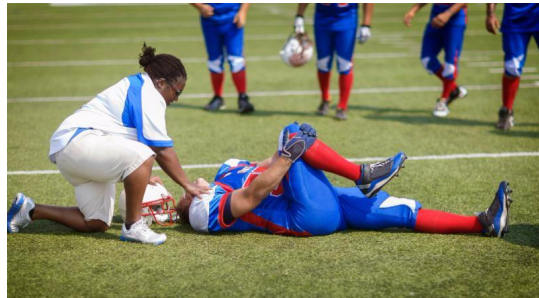
On April 9th, **Dr. John C. Clohisy** was the keynote for our Visiting Professor Series and led our topic of Challenging THA Case Review with his presentations of *Radiographic Interpretation of the Young Adult Hip* and *Borderline Dysplasia: Arthroscopic or Open?*

He presently serves as Vice Chair, Chief of Adult Reconstructive Surgery and Director of the Adolescent and Young Adult Hip Service in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at Washington University School of Medicine. Dr. Clohisy's clinical expertise includes hip joint preservation (arthroscopy, osteotomies, impingement procedures), and hip replacement surgery. His research focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of pre-arthritis and early arthritic hip disorders, and on hip replacement procedures in young patients.
