Considerations for Guest Safety amidst the COVID-19 Environment
March 13, 2020 Statement

The outbreak of the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) has become an issue of enormous scale and human impact, and our hearts go out to all who have been affected.

The Campbell Foundation and the Campbell Clinic consider the health and well-being of our patrons and patients of utmost priority. As such, an Ad-Hoc Committee has been formed within Campbell Clinic with responsibility for close monitoring of the situation, and to provide policy and procedural guidance. This group has recommended cancellation of all conferences and large gatherings through April 30, 2020.

Based on this guidance, the Campbell Foundation will postpone the sold-out Footprints in Motion signature fundraiser scheduled for Friday, April 17, 2020 at the FedEx Event Center at Shelby Farms.

The Development Office staff are working on contingency plans now and will provide regular communication about Footprints in Motion as soon as possible.

Please know that the work your support makes possible still goes on.
